The Electrical Engineering and Computer Science Department at The University of Toledo invites applications for candidates for a full-time instructional position in our BSCSE program located at Lorain County Community College in Elyria, OH (approximately 30 miles Southwest of Cleveland) beginning immediately. The position will be a continuing non-tenure track appointment, contingent upon satisfactory performance and instructional need. Appointment will be at the assistant/associate professor rank depending upon qualifications and experience. The applicant must have expertise in Computer Science and Engineering. Areas of particular interest include object-oriented programming, data structures, operating systems, computer architecture and software engineering. All applicants should have a commitment to excellence in teaching. The successful candidate is expected to teach a variety of fundamental computer science courses including programming (Java/C++/Assembly), data structures and algorithms, operating systems, computer architecture, discrete mathematics, and software engineering in support of the LCCC program, as well as, encourage and direct undergraduate research and senior design projects. Candidates must possess an earned doctorate in computer science or computer engineering or a closely related field, where an earned undergraduate degree in computer science or engineering is highly desirable.
